## A RESOLUTION TO CREATE THE RED FOX MEADOWS FIRE SYSTEM RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2019-06

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners may order and create a rural improvement district upon the receipt of a petition to create a rural improvement district that contains the consent of all of the property to be included in the District, as per MCA 7-12-2102(2); and

WHEREAS, the attached letter, Exhibit "A", serving as the petition to create a rural improvement district, contains the signature of both owners of property to be included within the District; and

WHEREAS, the subdivision applicant for the proposed Red Fox Meadows Subdivision was granted preliminary approval on September 17, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the subdivision applicant has requested the creation of a rural improvement district to satisfy Condition of Approval No. 11 of the Red Fox Meadows Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the designated items set forth in MCA 7-12-2103(2) are as follows:

- 1. The designated number of the District is 2019-06.
- 2. The boundaries of the District are shown on Exhibit "B", which encompass the boundaries of the Red Fox Meadows Subdivision and the adjacent Tract 3A-1A-1 of COS # 3339439.
- 3. Maintenance:
  - a. The general character of maintenance includes maintenance of the fire system, contractual payments for the water, and a demand service charge fee, as detailed on Exhibit "C."
  - Maintenance of these improvements for the preliminarily approved Red Fox Meadows Subdivision are within the scope of service for the Red Fox Meadows Road RID No. 2019-06.
- 4. The County Engineer, or his designee, is to have charge of the work. The estimated cost per year for funding said maintenance is \$9,292.50 per year, as shown on Exhibit "C". All maintenance funds collected for the District will be spent solely on maintenance within the District.
- 5. The method by which the costs shall be assessed is described in MCA 7-12- 2151(d): "each lot, tract, or parcel of land in the district [will] be assessed an equal amount based upon the total cost of the [maintenance of improvements]."
- 6. Pursuant to MCA 7-12-2103(2)(f), "if an increase occurs in the number of benefitted lots, tracts, or parcels within the boundaries of the proposed district during the term of the bonded indebtedness, the assessment per lot, tract, or parcel then in the district will be recalculated as provided in MCA 7-21-2151(4)."

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners,

 That it does hereby create the Red Fox Meadows Fire System Rural Improvement District No. 2019-06 for the purpose of equitably funding maintenance of the fire protection improvements, the contractual payments for the water, and the electrical demand service charge.

2. That the Board of County Commissioners have determined pursuant to MCA 7-12-2108 that the contemplated work is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and that the expense of such work is chargeable upon the lots and land fronting upon proposed improvements and upon other lots and lands not fronting on the proposed improvements, which are the property benefited by said work and to be assessed to pay the cost and expense thereof.

 That the Lewis and Clark County Public Works Department is authorized and responsible for coordinating maintenance as described on Exhibit "C" within the

District boundary as shown on Exhibit "B".
