<u>Contract Between Lewis and Clark County/PureView Health Center and National</u> <u>Council for Behavioral Health. (Jill Steeley)</u>

Jill Steeley, Executive Director of PureView, presented the contract with National Council for Behavioral Health in the amount of \$4,500 for case to care training for the PureView staff and other non profit agencies that conduct case management services. The training is about taking the next step to ensure the patients follow through on received referrals. Ms. Steeley gave a brief overview of some of the other partners involved.

Commissioner Good Geise asked if the other partners will be contributing to the cost and Ms. Steeley noted PureView has a grant to cover the costs.
