

#### **PUBLIC MEETING**

July 18, 2019 MINUTES

The Lewis and Clark County Commissioners Public Meeting was held on Thursday, July 18, 2019, at 9:00 AM in Commission Chambers Room 330.

## **Roll Call**

Chairman Jim McCormick called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

# Resolution 2019-65 to Create a Special District to be Known as the Lincoln Cemetery District. (Pam Attardo)

Pam Attardo, Heritage Preservation Officer, presented the resolution to create the Special District to be known as Lincoln Cemetery District. On April 5, 2019 the Commission approved the resolution of intention to create the District. The District will consist of the Old Lincoln Cemetery and the Memorial Meadows Cemetery and the District is not taxable. The Old Lincoln Cemetery has both a pioneer and contemporary section. When the land was transferred to Lewis and Clark County it was agreed upon with the Helena-Lewis and Clark National Forest Service that a fence would be built around the pioneer section to keep the section historic. There is a plan to repair or replace some grave fences.

Commissioner Good Geise asked why the picket fence is so expensive at \$8,000 and Ms. Attardo stated the number is on the conservative side and other options will be considered.

Ms. Attardo gave a history of the Old Lincoln Cemetery including the deed dated June 28, 2016 and the Memorandum of Agreement dated May of 2016 that outlines the County's responsibilities, one of which is to create a Cemetery District for the daily operation, management, maintenance and historic preservation of the property, as well as oversight of burials in the contemporary portion of the cemetery. There will be an upcoming resolution to create and appoint the board for the District. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

No pubic comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Good Geise and seconded by Commissioner Hunthausen. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.
