



PUBLIC MEETING

August 9, 2022

MINUTES

The Lewis and Clark County Commissioners Public Meeting was held on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, at 9:00 AM in Commission Chambers, Room 330.

Roll Call

Chair Jim McCormick called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

Commissioner Tom Rolfe and Commissioner Hunthausen were present. Others attending all or a portion of the meeting included Roger Baltz, Nicho Hash, Jenny Chambers, Robert McCarley, Kari DesRosier, and Brandi Spangler, Recording Secretary.

Pledge of Allegiance

Everyone recited the pledge.

Consent Action Items

Contract Between Lewis and Clark County and Home Beautifiers. (Jenny Chambers).

Jenny Chambers, Public Works Director, presented a contract with Home Beautifiers for providing and installing draperies in the Courthouse for an amount of \$38,162 with work completed by December 31, 2022. Project is in 2023 fiscal year budget. The current draperies are over 30 years old and at the end of their lifespan, unable to be cleaned due to liability of risk of damage. Due to preserving historical look, the draperies are being custom made and the current hardware is going to be used to install them. Staff recommends approval.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Rolfe and seconded by Commissioner Hunthausen. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Labor Agreement Between Lewis and Clark County and the Laborers' International Union, Local #1686. (Kari DesRosier)

Kari DesRosier, Human Resources Director, presented the labor agreement with Laborers' International Union, Local #1686. The agreement period is July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024. Changes include period of coverage for the contract, grammatical and formatting edits, 20-minute rest breaks for working 10-hour shifts, on call rate for Clerk of Courts office from \$1.00 per hour to \$1.50 per hour, pay increases each year, updated pay matrix and longevity table. This contract is for laborers' group which includes non-supervisors in the departments of Public Works, Treasurers Clerk/Recorder, Justice Court, and District Court offices. Members have ratified the agreement and staff recommends approval.

Commissioner McCormick asked for Ms. DesRosier to explain the process of negotiations. The contract took three meetings of negotiations and some further emails, a tentative contract, and finally, a final contract to be presented to the Commission.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Hunthausen and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Public comment on any public matter within the jurisdiction of the Commission that is not on the agenda above.


There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:12 a.m.
