Contract Agreement Between Lewis and Clark County and Lincoln School District No. 38. (Eric Merchant)

Eric Merchant, Division Administrator for Disease Control and Prevention, presented the contract between with the Lincoln School District No. 38 for public health services. The agreement will provide vision screenings for all students in grades 1, 3, 5 and 8; hearing screenings for students in grades K, 1 and 9; and immunization record assessments for students K-12. The contract period begins September 1, 2016 through June 1, 2017 in the amount of \$1,440.

The agreement will provide vision screenings for all students and referrals; scoliosis screenings for 5th and 6th grade students; health education; and

immunization assessments. The contract period begins September 1, 2016 through June 1, 2017 in the amount of \$1,440.
