

PUBLIC MEETING

July 2, 2024 MINUTES

The Lewis and Clark County Commissioners Public Meeting was held on Tuesday, July 2, 2024, at 9:00 AM in Commission Chambers, Rm 330.

Roll Call

Chair Andy Hunthausen called the meeting to order at 9 a.m.

Pledge of Allegiance

Everyone recited the pledge.

Consent Action Items

a. Letter of Support for the Bureau of Reclamation's Canyon Ferry Dam Bridge Rehabilitation Application. (Roger Baltz)

[:58] Roger Baltz, Chief Administrative Officer, reported on consent action item 2a and recommended approval.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Payne and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Bid Award Update. Lower D2 Ditch Flood Mitigation Project - Precast Materials. (Dan Karlin)

[2:00] Dan Karlin, County Engineer, gave an update for the lower D2 Ditch Flood Mitigation Project budget-precast materials bid award. One bid was received and was over by \$180,000. A meeting to discuss the budget is set for this afternoon. Staff requests coming back with a recommendation on July 11, 2024. No public comment was received.

Commissioner Rolfe made a motion for staff to come back with a recommendation on July 11, 2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Payne. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Resolution 2024-64 to Create the Oro Fino Rural Improvement District No. 2024-2. (Jessica Makus)

[5:14] Jessica Makus, Special Districts Coordinator, presented a resolution to create the Oro Fino Rural Improvement District. Each benefiting property will be assessed of \$909 annually for a total improvement assessment of \$317,641 for a 15-year debt service and an additional \$230 per year for maintenance. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Payne and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Grant Award to Lewis and Clark Public Health from the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services. (Sarah Sandau)

[22:31] Sarah Sandau, Community Health Promotion Division Administrator, presented a grant award from the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services for the Chronic Disease Prevention Programs in the amount of \$326,097. The grant period is from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. Staff recommends approval of the grant award.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Rolfe and seconded by Commissioner Payne. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.

Board Appointment. (Roger Baltz)

[26:23] Roger Baltz, Chief Administrative Officer, presented a board appointment for the Augusta Solid Waste District Board. Staff recommends the Commission consider the applicants, Lloyd Allen and Brian Moody, and select a candidate to complete a term that expires December 31, 2024.

No public comment was received.

Commissioner Payne made a motion to select Brian Moody for the Augusta Solid Waste District Board to a term that expires December 31, 2024. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3-0 vote.
