

# PUBLIC MEETING July 9, 2024 MINUTES

The Lewis and Clark County Commissioners Public Meeting was held on Tuesday, July 9, 2024, at 9:00 AM in Commission Chambers, Rm 330.

#### Roll Call

### <u>Professional Services Contract Between Lewis and Clark Public Health and PureView Health Center. (Drenda Niemann)</u>

[2:00] Drenda Niemann, Public Health Officer, presented a professional services contract with PureView Health Center to provide HIV case management services in the amount of \$21,000. The term begins July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. Staff recommends approval of the contract.

#### Resolution 2024-67. Intention to Expend County Title III Funds. (Ann McCauley)

Proposed projects include the City of Helena to conduct fuels treatment, and Tri-County FireSafe Working Group to conduct fuels treatment and home ignition zone assessments. Legal notice will be posted in the Helena Independent Record and the comment period will end on August 26, 2024 at 4pm. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.
