

RESOLUTION 2014-41

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PROSECUTORIAL ASSISTANCE

Whereas, the Lewis & Clark County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in representing the County and State in the case of the *State of Montana vs. Jenny Marie Buchman*, Cause No. ADC 2013-68 of the Montana First Judicial District Court, Lewis and Clark County, and

Whereas, it is desired and deemed appropriate that a special deputy county attorney be appointed to assist in the investigation and prosecution of the aforementioned case; and

Whereas, upon the approval of the board of county commissioners, § 7-4-2402, MCA, authorizes the county to appoint such deputy officers as may be necessary for the faithful and prompt discharge of the duties of the Office of County Attorney; and

Whereas, John W. Parker and Cascade County Deputy County Attorneys delegated by him are attorneys licensed to practice law who are willing to act as a special deputy county attorney on behalf of the State in the prosecution.

Now, Therefore, It Is Hereby Resolved:

That John W. Parker and Cascade County Deputy County Attorneys delegated by him are hereby appointed as special deputy county attorneys for Lewis and Clark County for the purpose of the prosecution of the aforementioned case and may act in the same capacity and have the same privileges, powers and immunities as a salaried County Attorney or Deputy County Attorney of Lewis and Clark County.

It is Further Resolved:

That under the terms of this agreement, no fee shall be charged for attorney time provided by the Montana Department of Transportation, however, witness fees and expenses, jury costs, and other normal costs associated with trial will be the county's responsibility as with all other prosecutions.
