A RESOLUTION DECLARING COUNTY PROPERTY SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Section 7-8-2211, MCA, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to sell, trade, or exchange any real or personal property, however acquired, belonging to the County that is not necessary to the conduct of county business or the preservation of its property; and

WHEREAS, the County property described on the attached list is useful as a sealant, since it provides a self-sealing, low permeability barrier. It will be useful locally to line irrigations canals, or retention ponds, or other infrastructure projects,


WHEREAS, the property described as excess bentonite clay has a value of \$2,500 or more and is indicated therein; and

WHEREAS, the revenue from the sale of the property will be used to offset operating cost, which will be used to keep our tipping fees low.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lewis and Clark County Commissioners that said this property is declared surplus property, and that it will be sold at current market value.


