

RESOLUTION 2016-30

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY
LANDFILL FEE RATES AS RECOMMENDED BY THE SCRATCHGRAVEL
SOLID WASTE DISTRICT, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016**

WHEREAS, Section 7-11-1024, MCA, states the Board of County Commissioners may impose fees for the costs and expenses of the Lewis and Clark County Landfill based upon budget; and

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Landfill serves the Scratchgravel Solid Waste District, the Marysville Solid Waste Subservice Area, and the City of Helena; and

WHEREAS, the Scratchgravel Solid Waste District Board and the Board of County Commissioners in Resolution 2011-97 established the current landfill fees.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the Scratchgravel Solid Waste District met on April 12, 2016 and recommended changes in the landfill fees to maintain and operate the County landfill, purchase equipment, make debt service payments, and to maintain adequate cash reserves.

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2016 the Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution 2016-29, A Resolution of Intention to Establish the Lewis and Clark County Landfill Fees, Beginning July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2016 the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on its intention to increase the County landfill tipping fees; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis and Clark County that it does hereby establish its intention to set the following landfill tipping fee rates to be effective on July 1, 2016;

*Municipal Solid Waste Tipping Fee – Class II	\$30.00 per ton
Special Loads Solid Waste Tipping Fee – Class II	
Liquid Waste	\$ 7.00 per ton
Compost	\$10.00 per ton
Dead Animal	\$50.00 per ton
Asbestos	\$30.00 per ton
^Contaminated Soil	\$10.00 - \$30.00 per ton
Wastewater Sludge and Bar Screenings	\$50.00 per ton
Construction and Demolition Waste – Class IV	
Acceptable Materials	\$23.00 per ton
Unacceptable Materials	\$50.00 per ton
Accounts Receivable Reactivation Fee	\$25.00




* Variable MSW Class II rates may be adjusted based on operational assessment to include waste volumes, contract terms and fiscal impacts.

^ Soil tipping fee will be based on analytical results, volumes, contract terms and fiscal impacts.


