## **RESOLUTION 2016-73**

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING AN ANNUAL LEVY FOR FIFTEEN YEARS FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS COSTS FOR THE COUNTY'S PROPOSED REMODELED DETENTION CENTER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY, MONTANA, as follows:

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark County (the "County") is a public body and is authorized pursuant to Section 15-10-425, MCA, to impose a new mill levy or exceed the mill levy limit provided for in Section 15-10-420, MCA by conducting an election authorizing such new mill levy for County purposes; and

WHEREAS, the County is in the process of designing, remodeling, expanding, equipping, furnishing and financing its detention center located at 221 Breckenridge in Helena, Montana (the "Facility"), which is intended to be funded by County General Obligation Bonds, upon the completion of a successful election; and

WHEREAS, when the Facility is expanded and remodeled, the County wants to ensure that the County has the financial capacity to properly operate and maintain the Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the County intends, upon the successful completion of the bond election and subsequent remodeling of the Facility, to establish an annual detention center operation and maintenance levy for fifteen years, pursuant to Section 15-10-425, MCA, in order to pay the costs of maintenance and operation of the Facility, including additional staff, services and programs; and

WHEREAS, the County/is conducting a general obligation bond election to authorize the issuance of up to \$6,300,000 in aggregate principal amount of bonds with a term of 15 years to fund the design, equipping, furnishing and financing of its proposed remodeling of the Facility; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that if the general obligation bond election is successful, that an annual mill levy for fifteen years for the operation and maintenance of the Facility should be imposed; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated by the County that the annual operation and maintenance costs for the Facility, including additional staff, services and programs, will require a new levy of approximately 31.75 mills to raise \$4,000,000 annually for operation and maintenance costs, subject to the provisions of Section 15-10-420(1)(a),

MCA which allow for inflation and new growth in subsequent years to fund the operation and maintenance of the Facility; and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of a mill in the County, according to the most recent (2016) assessment for the state and county taxes, is \$125,989; and

WHEREAS, if the County obtains the voted authority for the levy to annually fund \$4,000,000 for operation and maintenance of the remodeled facility, based on 2016 assessment figures, the estimated new mills required would be 31.75; and

WHEREAS, the County estimates the tax increase for the levy for a home in the County valued at "Phased-in Market Value for tax purposes" at \$100,000 would be an annual increase of \$42.86 and for a home so valued at \$200,000 would be an annual increase of \$85.72.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby Resolved as follows:

1. <u>Calling of the Election</u>. The Board of County Commissioners of Lewis and Clark County, Montana, hereby calls and directs a County mill levy election to be held on November 8, 2016, in conjunction with the general obligation bond election, for the purpose of voting on the following question:

Shall the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to establish a detention center facility annual mill levy for 15 years of approximately 31.75 mills to raise \$4,000,000 annually for the operation and maintenance of the County's proposed remodeled detention center facility, including additional staff, services and programs, where the new levy of approximately 31.75 mills to raise \$4,000,000 annually will be subject to Section 15-10-420(1)(a), MCA after the first year allowing for inflationary growth and newly taxable growth?

It is estimated by the County that, using current assessed values of taxable property, for a home valued at \$100,000, taxes would be increased annually by the levy in the amount of \$42.86 and for a home valued at \$200,000, taxes would be increased annually by the levy in the amount of \$85.72.

The imposition of the annual levy for 15 years for maintenance and operation of the proposed remodeled detention center facility is contingent on the voter approval of the \$6,500,000 general obligation bonds of the County for such remodeling of the facility.

2. <u>Conduct of the Election</u>. All qualified electors of the County shall be entitled to vote at the mill levy election. The Lewis and Clark County Election

Administrator is hereby requested and authorized to give proper notice of the close of registration and thereafter prepare printed lists of the electors in the County entitled to vote in the election in the County and to conduct the election in the form and manner prescribed by law.

3. <u>Notice of Election</u>. The Election Administrator is hereby authorized and requested to cause notice of the call and holding of the election to be given by publishing notice at least once a week for the three consecutive weeks before the election in the Independent Record, a newspaper of general circulation in the County. The notice of election as published shall read substantially as follows:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") of Lewis and Clark County, Montana (the "County"), that pursuant to a certain resolution duly adopted at the regular meeting of the Board on August 9, 2016, a mill levy election of the registered voters of the County will be held on November 8, 2016, in conjunction with the general obligation bond election, for the purpose of voting on the following question:

Shall the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to establish a detention center facility annual mill levy for 15 years of approximately 31.75 mills to raise \$4,000,000 annually for the operation and maintenance of the County's proposed remodeled detention center facility, including additional staff, services and programs, where the new levy of approximately 31.75 mills to raise \$4,000,000 annually will be subject to Section 15-10-420(1)(a), MCA after the first year allowing for inflationary growth and newly taxable growth?

It is estimated by the County that, using current assessed values of taxable property, for a home valued at \$100,000, taxes would be increased annually by the levy in the amount of \$42.86 and for a home valued at \$200,000, taxes would be increased annually by the levy in the amount of \$85.72.
