**ADOPTING THE LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY
PRE-DISASTER MITIGATION PLAN 2017 UPDATE**

WHEREAS, in October of 2000 the President of the United States signed into law the "Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000" (PL 106-390) to amend the "Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988" which among other provisions requires local governments to adopt a Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark County, Montana has worked closely with Lewis and Clark County Disaster and Emergency Services to update a county-wide Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan that will serve the needs of Lewis and Clark County; and

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark County supports the 2017 Update to the Lewis and Clark County Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan as a logical means toward protecting people and property from the potential devastating effects of natural and man-made hazards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lewis and Clark County Board of County Commissioners adopt, by way of this resolution, the "Lewis and Clark County, Montana Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan – 2017 Update" as approved by the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
