

RESOLUTION 2019 - 69

A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE AN ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFYING OFFICIAL

WHEREAS, in order for Lewis and Clark County to apply for and receive federal, state, local and private funding to construct or rehabilitate affordable housing for low- and moderate-income persons, provide homebuyer and/or rent assistance, and provide economic development assistance, an Environmental Certifying Official must be appointed.

WHEREAS, the Environmental Certifying Official will produce an Environmental Review Record for projects funded and approved by the Montana Department of Commerce Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs conducted in Lewis and Clark County.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

1. That the Board considers it both advisable and necessary to appoint Ann McCauley, Grants Administrator, or designee, to be Lewis and Clark County's Environmental Certifying Official.

That a Public Hearing was held on 08/13/2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Chambers of the Board of County Commissioners, at the City-County Building, Helena, Montana, for the purpose of gathering and receiving testimony, input and comments from all interested or affected users, citizens, persons, associations, corporations and/or companies.
