Hi Karie,

John Baucus with Sieben Ranch Company called me this morning. The cattle and sheep PAC fees doubling error that occurred on Sieben Ranch Company's 2017 property tax bill also occurred on their 2016 property tax bill.

John said his 2016 property tax bill displays the predatory animal control (PAC) fees as \$1,920 for sheep and \$1,440 for cattle.

Attached is Sieben Ranch Company's 2016 livestock report from the livestock database and from their 2016 livestock record in the Orion system. Both systems have the correct head counts of 1,600 sheep and 720 cattle.

The correct 2016 PAC fees on their 2016 property tax bill should have been:

- Sheep 1,600 x \$0.60 = \$960
- Cattle 720 x \$1.00 = \$720

A \$1,680 refund is warranted as Sieben Ranch Company has already paid their 2016 property tax bill.

Hi Karie,

Thanks for talking to me on Monday regarding Sieben Ranch Company's 2017 PAC fees.

As discussed, the cattle and sheep PAC fees on the ranch's attached 2017 property tax bill are incorrect. The dollar amounts (\$2,348 for cattle and \$2,160 for sheep) are double of what was actually owed.

For 2017, Sieben Ranch Company reported 1,174 cattle and 1,800 sheep as shown on the attachments from the livestock database and Orion. The correct 2017 PAC fees should have been:

- Cattle $-1.174 \times $1.00 = 1.174
- Sheep $-1,800 \times $0.60 = $1,080$

A \$2,254 refund is warranted as Sieben Ranch Company has already paid their 2017 property tax bill.
