TERMINATION OF RESOLUTION 2020-12 DECLARING A LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 public health emergency that resulted in an Emergency Declaration on March 13, 2020 through Resolution 2020-12, continues to be present in the County and surrounding area but is no longer an imminent threat, and;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus is now a vaccine preventable disease and can be adequately addressed with existing resources, and;

WHEREAS, the response agencies and critical partners are ready to transition to the recovery phase of the emergency, and;


WHEREAS, the COVID-19 response structure has been institutionalized and can be reactivated to respond to surges of cases should they arise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lewis and Clark County Board of County Commissioners that the public health emergency is hereby terminated pursuant to Section 10-3-402 MCA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution will be filed with the Lewis and Clark County Clerk and Recorder's Office and the Montana Division of Disaster and Emergency Services Division.
