

RESOLUTION 2022 - 102

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-95 DECLARING COUNTY PROPERTY SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Section 7-8-2211, MCA, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to sell, trade, or exchange any real or personal property, however acquired, belonging to the County that is not necessary to the conduct of county business or the preservation of its property; and

WHEREAS, the County property described on the attached list has been determined by the Board of County Commissioners to be unnecessary to the conduct of county business or the preservation of its property and by such determination has been declared surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the property listed on Exhibit A reasonably has a value of \$2,500 or more and is indicated therein; and

WHEREAS, the County previously determined item No. 3 in Resolution 2022-95 to have a value of \$9,000, and


WHEREAS, on the morning of September 13, 2022 item No. 3 was involved in a collision with a deer which altered the resale value of the item, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lewis and Clark County Commissioners, that said county property is declared surplus property and the resale value is now \$4,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Lewis and Clark County Commission's action as to Resolution 2022-95 No. 3 is hereby amended.
