RESOLUTION TO CREATE THE AUGUSTA RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR **IMPROVEMENT NO. 2022-5**

WHEREAS, a resolution of intention to create the Augusta Rural Improvement District (the District) was adopted by the Lewis and Clark County Board of Commissioners (Commission) on March 3, 2022, as Resolution 2022-16; and

WHEREAS, legal notice of the passage of Resolution 2022-16 was mailed to property owners and persons of interest in property within the District, and published in the local newspaper in accordance with Section 7-12-2105, MCA, and 7-1-2121, MCA; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that there was not sufficient protest to bar proceedings as per Section 7-12-2112, MCA: and

WHEREAS, the designated items set forth in Section 7-12-21-03(2), MCA, are as follows:

- (a) The designated number of the District is 2022-5.
- (b) The benefited properties to be included in the District and the boundary of the District are identified on Exhibit "A".
- (c)The County Engineer or a designee will have charge of the work. The general character of improvements includes asphalt patching and chip sealing on hard surface roads included within the District. The estimated costs for improvements total \$120,667 and will be paid for with a seven (7) year debt service, with \$18.33 assessed annually to each benefited property. Improvement costs are detailed in Exhibit "B'.
- (d) The general character of maintenance includes, but is not limited to, crack sealing, pothole patching, and chip sealing to preserve the road surfaces. Each property is estimated to be assessed \$45.13, annually,
- (e) Costs shall be assessed equally, as described in Section 7-12-2151(1)(d), MCA.
- (f) Pursuant to Section 7-12-2103(2)(f), MCA, if an increase in the number of benefited lots, tracts, or parcels within the boundaries of the district during the term of bonded indebtedness, the assessment per lot, tract, or parcel then in the district will be recalculated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission does hereby create the Augusta Rural Improvement District No. 2022-5 for the purpose of equitably funding improvements for roadways in the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Lewis and Clark County Public Works Department is authorized and responsible for coordinating proposed improvements detailed in Exhibit "B" for roadways within the District.


