## **RESOLUTION 2024 - 12**

## A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE RED FOX MEADOWS STORMWATER RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2019-04

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Board of Commissioners (Board) may order and create a rural improvement district (RID) whenever the public interest or convenience may require, as per MCA 7-12-2102; and

**WHEREAS**, the Red Fox Meadows Stormwater Rural Improvement District, No. 2019-04, was created by the Board on October 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a resolution of intention to amend the Red Fox Meadows Stormwater RID was adopted by the Board on December 28, 2023, as Resolution 2023-108; and

**WHEREAS,** legal notice of the passage of Resolution 2023-108 was mailed to each property owner or person of interest in property within the proposed amended RID, and published in the local newspaper in accordance with MCA 7-12-2105, and MCA 7-1-2121; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that there was not sufficient protest to bar proceedings as per MCA 7-12-2112; and

WHEREAS, the designated items set forth in MCA 7-12-2103(2) are as follows:

- 1. The designated number of the existing Red Fox Meadows RID is 2019-04.
- 2. The boundaries of the RID are shown on Exhibit A, which encompass the boundaries of the Red Fox Meadows Subdivision.
- 3. The County Engineer, or his designee, is to have charge of the work. The general character of maintenance includes stormwater pond sediment removal, drainage ditch sediment removal/slope stability, weed control, necessary to preserve the improvements, as detailed in Exhibit B and Resolution 2019-101.
- 4. The estimated costs for annual maintenance total \$3,388.00 per year. Each benefited property is estimated to be assessed \$22.00, annually. All maintenance funds collected for the RID will be spent solely on maintenance within the RID.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners,

- That it does hereby amend the Red Fox Meadows Rural Improvement District No. 2019-04, to include the additional lots and infrastructure created through the Prestige at Red Fox Meadows subdivision located within the Red Fox Meadows RID, for the purpose of equitably funding the maintenance, preservation, and repair of the stormwater infrastructure within the Red Fox Meadows RID.
- 2. That the Board has determined pursuant to MCA 7-12-2108, that the contemplated work is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and that the expense of such work is chargeable upon the lots and land fronting upon proposed improvements and upon other lots and lands not fronting on the proposed improvements, which are the property benefited by said work and to be assessed to pay the cost and expense thereof.

3. That the Lewis and Clark County Public Works Department is authorized and responsible for coordinating maintenance as described in this resolution within the RID boundary as shown on Exhibit A.


