

-INVITATION TO BID-

The Lewis and Clark County Public Works Road Department is soliciting competitive bids from interested parties for the purchase of bulk magnesium chloride delivered to and off-loaded into our bulk holding facility located at 3402 Cooney Drive in Helena Montana.

All Bids must be in accordance with the contract documents on file at the Lewis and Clark County Public Works Office, 3402 Cooney Drive, Helena MT 59602. Bids will be considered based on the most responsible bid submitted and the following criteria: purchase price, product availability and specifications.

Sealed bids must be received at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners, Room 345, City-County Building, 316 N. Park Avenue, Helena, MT 59623 no later than 4:00 p.m. local time on June 3, 2024. The envelope containing the sealed bid will be labeled with the bidder's name, address, and "Mag Supply Bid Enclosed".

Bids will be opened and read aloud at the public meeting of the County Commissioners on June 4, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. local time in Room 330 of the City-County Building, 316 N. Park Avenue, Helena, MT.
