### **Entry Fees:**

There will be an all-day fee of \$25 for all entries received by 6/11. A late fee of \$10 will be charged for entries received after 6/11 up to 6/18. A late fee of \$15 will be charged for entries received the day of the show. A \$5 credit will be given to each participant who provides an all-day volunteer (must be established prior to 6/11/21 to be eligible for credit).

### **Entry Form:**

Email entries to Alison at [ponygirl0426@gmail.com](mailto:ponygirl0426@gmail.com). All entries received after 6/11 will be subject to a late fee. All fees will be collected when you check-in at the show. Please include the following in the entry email:

- Rider Name, 4H Age (as of Oct. 1) and levels
- Horse(s) Name(s) & age (as of Jan 1.)
- Class numbers to enter.

If you are using more than one horse, please indicate which classes each horse will be used in.

Classes may be added or dropped the day of the show with no additional charge. Classes must be added at the horse show office at least 1 class prior to ride time.

### **Rules and Descriptions**

- Helmets will be required for all riding classes.
- Participants will be judged with a danish system based on expected skills by 4H level instead of placings (Purple- Exceeds expectations, Blue- Meets expectations, Red- Minor improvements needed, White- Major improvements needed). Each placing will be worth a corresponding number of points. Participants can cash in their points for a variety of prizes that will be displayed at the prize table.
- Eligibility for each class will be based on current enrollment in the 4H horse project. If you have any questions about eligibility please reach out to the Project leaders.
- Participants cannot cross enter into the Walk-Trot and Canter/Lope Classes. C2M/Green Horses cannot cross enter into the regular project classes with the exception of C2M Level 5/Green Horse Level 4 and Horsemanship Level 7 per 4H Horse Policy. W/T participants may enter the Ranch Horse Horsemanship and jog instead of lope in the respective areas of the pattern.
- Equitation classes will be rail classes.
- Horsemanship classes will be pattern classes. Patterns will be available at the Horse Show office the day of the show. Level 7 participants have the option of providing their own pattern with music or using a provided pattern (A copy of the Pattern and music must be given to the horse show office at check-in).
- Montana 4H bit policy will be followed. If an illegal bit is being used, the rider will be given an opportunity to change bits. If no alternative legal bit is found, the rider/handler will be ineligible for placings in that class.
- Lewis and Clark County 4H Horse Policy will be followed for anything not mentioned in these rules.
- AQHA Rules will be followed for anything not mentioned in the 4H horse policies.
- Show Management reserves the right to dismiss anyone from the show grounds without a refund for unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Refunds only for horse or rider injury at the discretion of show management. A doctor/vet note may be requested.
