WHEREAS, the public interest require, and upon the petition of more than sjxty per cent of the feeeholders affected thereby, filed with the Clerk of thsi Board:

BE IT RESOLVED that it is the intention of this Board to create a special improvement district to be known as Special Improvement District No. 2 , for the purpose of building, constructing and maintaining a street lidhting system in the unincorporated town of Augusta, Lewis and Clark County, Montana, said district to be embraced within and to include the lands within the following described boundaries:
