RESOLUTION 1985 - 54

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CREATE RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1985-2 OF LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY, MONTANA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received a petition from the freeholders of Prickly Pear Creek Estates for the creation of a rural improvement district, and

WHEREAS, an engineer's estimate has been received, and

WHEREAS, it has been certified that the signature of said petition does represent 100% of the affected freeholders.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis and Clark County, Montana, that:

Section 1: A Rural Improvement District Number 1985-2 is created;

Section 2: The proposed RID will be in a thickly populated locality outside all city limits:

Section 3: The boundaries of said RID are indicated in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference are made a part of this resolution;

Section 4: The character of the improvements proposed to be constructed are for maintenance of all public roads including dust seal applications.

Section 5: The estimated cost of the maintenance contemplated including engineering, inspection, legal and administration is \$9,603.00 per year.

Section 6: The total area of the lots to be assessed is 1,019,783 square feet and the estimated cost per square foot is .00942 dollars.

Section 7: The engineer for this project shall be the County Surveyor.

Section 8: The entire cost of said maintenance shall be paid by the entire district, with each lot bearing its cost as the square footage of the lot is to the total square footage of the entire district, the estimated average cost is \$147.74 per lot.

Section 9: On the 15th day of October 1985, at 9:00 a.m., in Room 309 of the City-County Building, the Board shall meet, consider, and pass upon all protests against the creation of said district or against the purchase or making of the improvements referred to herein, which are in writing and delivered to the Lewis and Clark County Clerk and Recorder at any time within fifteen days of September 29, 1985, the date of the first publication of the notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention.

Section 10: Assessments shall begin in November, 1986, with only those lots that have been approved through the filing of a final subdivision plat being assessed.
