

RESOLUTION NO. 1981-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF LEWIS AND CLARK, MONTANA, CREATING A RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1981-1, FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING AND MAINTAINING A LIGHTING SYSTEM AND FURNISHING ELECTRICAL ENERGY THERETO TO A PORTION OF THE PLEASANT VALLEY SUBDIVISION, AS FILED IN THE LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDER'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, at a regular session of the County Commission of the County of Lewis and Clark, held on the 27th day of October, 1981, said County Commissioners duly passed Resolution No. 1981-42, declaring it to be the intention of said County Commission to create a rural special improvement district to be known and designated as Rural Special Improvement District No. 1981-1, for the purpose of operating and maintaining a lighting system and furnishing electrical energy thereto to a portion of the Pleasant Valley Subdivision, as filed in the Lewis and Clark County Clerk and Recorder's Office and being more particularly described as:

Lots 1 - 41 inclusive; lots 50, 51, 60,  
61, 70, 71, 80, 81, 90, 91, 100, 101;  
lots 110 - 127 inclusive; lots 136 - 150  
inclusive.

Said Commission Resolution No. 1981-42 is hereby referred to and made a part hereof for further particulars in respect to the boundaries of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 1981-1, and the estimated cost of said improvements and the method of assessing the same against the property of said district; and

WHEREAS, notice of the passage of said Commission Resolution No. 1981-42 was duly published as required by law, in the Independent Record, a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Helena, Montana, and by sending a copy of such notice by United States mail to each person, firm, or corporation having property within the proposed district at his or its last known address, upon the same date that such notice was first published as aforesaid, and due

proof having been made of the publication and services of said notices; and WHEREAS, within the time provided by law and said published and served notice, there were not sufficient protests against the creation of said Rural Special Improvement District No. 1981-1, and the County Commission was in regular session on the 27th day of October, 1981, at 9 o'clock a .m., of said day, at the office of the County Commission in the City-County Building in Helena, Montana, the same being the time and place designated in said notice for passing upon all protests, if any, against the creation of said district; and it further appearing that all of the proceedings for the creation of said district having been lawful and regular.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF LEWIS AND CLARK:

SECTION 1

That the said Rural Special Improvement District No. 1981-1 of the County of Lewis and Clark, be and the same is hereby created for the purpose of operating and maintaining improvements as in said Commission Resolution No. 1981-42 and hereinafter described.

SECTION 2

That said improvements be, and the same are, hereby ordered to be made in said Rural Special Improvement District No. 1981-1 as follows:

(1) The operation and maintenance of lighting facilities, consisting of thirty-two (32) units, with underground wiring, steel poles for 25-foot mounting height, and glass enclosed luminaires with 70 watt high pressure sodium vapor lamps, furnished by and owned by the Montana Power Company and,

(2) The furnishing of electrical energy thereto.

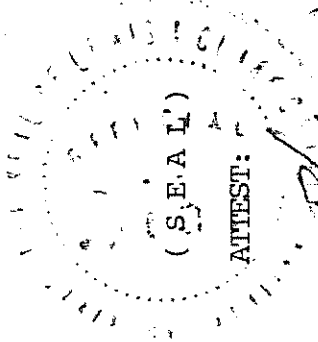
SECTION 3

That the entire expense of operating and maintaining the improvements herein described shall be assessed against the entire district as described herein. Each lot within the district shall be assessed for that portion of the whole cost which its area bears to the total area of the

district. The total area to be assessed is 88,094.  
The estimated annual cost is approximately \$.00501 per square foot of  
property, subject to rate changes as approved by the Public Service  
Commission of the State of Montana.

day of October, 1981.



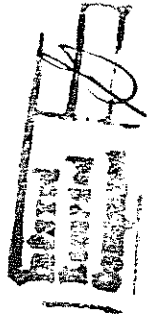
