A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CREATE RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1985-1 OF LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY, MONTANA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received a petition from the freeholders of Riddock Subdivision for the creation of a rural special improvement district, and

WHEREAS, an engineer's estimate has been received, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk and Recorder has certified the signatures of said petition does represent 71% of the affected freeholders.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis and Clark County, Montana, that:

Section 1: A Rural Special Improvement District Number 1985-1 is created;

Section 2: The proposed RSID is a thickly populated locality outside all city limits:

Section 3: The boundaries of said RSID are indicated in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference are made a part of this resolution;

- a) grading and laying of 24 feet of chip seal on the 60 foot county right-of-way
- b) eight feet of dust abatement treatment on each side of chip seal
- the establishment of a Maintenance District for said improvements

Section 5: The estimated cost of the improvements contemplated including engineering, inspection, legal and administration is \$10,246.

Section 6: The total area of the lots to be assessed is 347,766 square feet and the estimated cost per sq. ft. is .029462 cents. (Lot size 138×140 ft.)

Section 7: The engineer for this project shall be the county surveyor.

Section 8: The entire cost of said improvements shall be paid by the entire district, with each lot bearing its cost as the square footage of the lot is to the total square footage of the entire district, the estimated cost is \$559.227/jot plus interest, to be repair, within two years.

Section 9: On the 28th day of June , 1985, at 9:00 a.m., in Rnom 309 of the City-County Building, the board shall meet, consider, and pass upon all protests against the creation of said district or against the purchase or making of the improvements referred to herein, which are in writing and delivered to Lewis and Clark County Clerk and Recorder at any time within fifteen days of June 5, 1985, the date of the first publication of the notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention.
