

RESOLUTION NO. 1992 - 114

A RESOLUTION LEVYING AND ASSESSING A TAX UPON ALL BENEFITED PROPERTY WITHIN THE TENNESON ROAD RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners did create the Tenneson Road Rural Improvement District; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commission did pass Resolution 1992-105, "A Resolution Levying and Assessing a Tax Upon All Benefited Property Within the Tenneson Road Rural Improvement District", pursuant to state law (7-12-2158 MCA), which included a repayment schedule for each parcel, which is made a part of this Resolution by reference; and,

WHEREAS, notices of the levy and assessment was given to the property owners of the district by the posting in three places within the district, publishing of a legal advertisement two times in the Independent Record and the mailing of individual notices to the district property owners of record; and,

WHEREAS, the notices did allow the owners to object to the levy and assessment on their property by September 3; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commission did hold a Public Hearing at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, September 3, 1992 for the hearing and ruling on all objections received to the proposed assessments; and,

WHEREAS, the County Commission did not receive any objections to the assessments.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY, that the commission confirms the resolution to levy and assess a tax upon all benefitted property within the boundaries of the district.
