

Resolution 1987 - 39

A Resolution Creating Treasure State Acres No. 5 Rural Improvement District
No. 1987-2

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lewis and Clark County has received a petition requesting the creation of a rural improvement district for Treasure States Subdivision No. 5 for the maintenance of roads and drainage; and,

WHEREAS, the road maintenance costs are estimated at \$1,000 for snow removal, surface maintenance and replacement and repair; and

WHEREAS, the drainage maintenance costs are estimated at \$400.00 per year for cleaning of sump and drainage, and replacement of drainfield piping; and

WHEREAS, the Commission did pass a Resolution of Intent to create the rural improvement district on June 15, 1987; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly advertised and held on July 7, 1987; and,

WHEREAS, no protests to the creation of this rural improvement district were received.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Treasure State Acres No. 5 Rural Improvement District 1987-2 is created.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the boundaries of said district are proposed as follows: the southwest 1/4 of Section 8, T10N, R3W, P.M.M., Lewis and Clark County, containing 9.45 acres.
