## RESOLUTION 2005- **33**

## A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO CREATE THE WOODLAWN PARK RURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2005-3

WHEREAS, Lewis and Clark County has worked cooperatively with landowners and other agencies to facilitate the installation of water and wastewater improvements in the Woodlawn Park, to the Fairgrounds and to the Laborer's Union complex; and

WHEREAS, due to health and environmental concerns, the wastewater improvements have been deemed necessary at this time and water improvements will be installed at a later date; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater improvements will be funded through a combination of monies from a Treasure State Endowment Program Grant (TSEP), a State and Tribal Assistance Grant (STAG), Lewis and Clark County, and through a loans from the State Revolving Fund and Lewis and Clark County; and

WHEREAS, the loans are to be repaid by landowners in the district through creation of a Rural Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Commission has the authority to create Rural Improvement Districts for the purpose of funding wastewater facilities and water facilities pursuant to 7-12-2101, et. seq., MCA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission does hereby establish its intention to create the Woodlawn Park Rural Improvement District No. 2005-3 for the purpose of equitably funding wastewater facilities and future water facilities for the Woodlawn Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the district will include those benefiting properties described as Blocks 1 through 8 of the Woodlawn Park and Parcel D on Certificate of Survey No. 447163/O and that the boundaries of the district are shown on Exhibit "A" and listed on Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part thereof. Each platted lot 25-feet in width within the district benefits and is to be assessed a flat fee for the improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the engineer for the initial study is Stahly Engineering and Associates, with additional engineering services to be provided by an engineer selected through the County's contracting procedures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the improvements may include, but are not limited to the installation of an eight-inch sewer main, 48-inch manholes, gravel placement, unpaved street replacement, paved street replacement, reclamation and seeding, system development fees, meters and other facilities and/or costs associated with providing wastewater treatment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual total costs for the improvements to be paid by the State Revolving Fund loan are \$2,572.17 for a period of twenty (20) years and that because each platted lot 25-feet in width lot benefits, it is to be assessed \$7.23 annually. All funds collected for the improvement district shall be spent solely for the improvements within the district.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual total costs for the improvements to be paid by the loan from Lewis and Clark County State are \$4,559.10 for a period of twenty (20) years and that each connection to the system will be assessed \$87.68 annually.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on-going wastewater charges for individual monthly hookups will be billed directly to the property owner by the City on a monthly basis, according to Helena City Code (6-3-2). The costs are estimated at \$17.24 per month for disposal, administrative and operating reserve.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that future water improvements may be installed and could include, but are not limited to installation of water mains, valves, and hydrants. Costs for said improvements will be evaluated at the time they are needed and a resolution levying and assessing the costs for said improvements will be passed at that time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that enlargement of the City of Helena Water and Sewer Service area is subject to approval of the City Commision according to City Code (6-5-1 through 6-5-7).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when connection is made to the City of Helena wastewater facilities, a waiver of right to protest future annexation will be required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any owner of property within the proposed districts may make protest against the creation of the districts, pursuant to Section 7-12-2109, MCA.


