

HISTORIC HELENA WALKING TOURS

Summer guided walking tours for 2024 are offered **Sunday afternoons at 4:00 p.m.;** \$5/person, children are free:

JUNE - *Helena's Historic Last Chance Gulch - Old Main Street*. Examine the Queen City of the Rockies' existing historic architecture, as well as those now gone, and see the original gold discovery site where it all began! Meet by the Lewis & Clark Library, 120 S. Last Chance Gulch, on the Downtown Walking Mall.

JULY - Lost Glories, Living Legends. Explore Helena's early Upper West Side before the mansions were there. The tour is a step back to the 1880's, Helena's golden age, a time of tremendous growth and prosperity. Park in the north parking lot (on Lawrence St.) of the City-County Building, 316 N. Park Ave.; meet at the northwest corner of the City-County Building.

AUGUST - Mansions & Millionaires, Helena's West Side Neighborhood. See Montana's largest concentration of architecturally significant historic residences. Meet at the corner of Madison and Stuart Streets.
